FORMAT FOR PUBLIC SERVICE PROPOSALS

Public service agencies with a proposed project for the Community Development Block Grant 49th Program Year 2023-2024 Fiscal Year, should first review the Basic Eligibility Activities provided in the attached copy of the Federal Register 24 CFR Parts 570.201- 570.206.

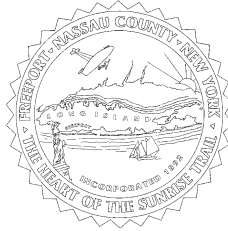
All proposed activities must meet one of the following national objectives: 1) Benefitting low-and-moderate income persons; 2) Prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and, 3) Meeting a community development need having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community (usually applied to national disasters).

FIVE (5) complete and legible copies of all proposals are required. In addition, all proposals should include:

- 1) A brief description of the nature and purpose of the project.
- 2) The estimated cost of the project, including a detailed budget if possible, and other sources of funding, where applicable.
- 3) Project Location.
- 4) Beneficiaries of the project, e.g. age, income, total number of persons benefited, etc.
- 5) Name, address and telephone number of contact person:

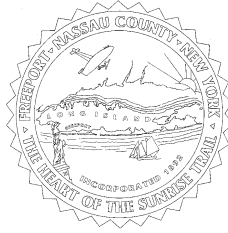
