Dock Rental Application and Agreement (page 2)

1. By application and acceptance of permit here under, the owner thereby waives any and all claims against the town and its representatives, and agrees to hold them harmless from any liability of a boat by the owner, and for any liability arising from weather conditions, extreme tides, wind or rain, theft, fire, shoaling, or any other condition that is considered to be an inherent risk involved in the ownership, operation, docking or mooring of boats and other vessels.
2. A permit granted by the Village of Freeport pursuant to this chapter shall not be assigned or transferred, and the space which pertains to such permit may not be subleased to allow a boat to be moored or docked therein by any person other than the person and boat to which such permit was assigned and issued. A marina permit may be canceled forthwith as the discretion of the Village of Freeport (VoF).
3. All applications must be filled out completely and accompanied with: a Current Driver's license and a Valid State Boat Registration. Applications without these documents may not be processed.
4. *Renewal applications will be sent out in November for the following season and must be returned by mid-December to avoid forfeiture to the next person on the waiting list. It is the responsibility of the boat owner to make an inquiry if a renewal application is not received by December 5th. Renewal applicants must pay by mid-February. **PAYMENT MUST BE MADE IN FULL PRIOR TO DOCKAGE!**
5. If you qualify for any of the discounts, please be aware that the discount may not be honored if paperwork/payment is not made by the timeline shown above.
6. When the application is processed, an invoice will be issued. To avoid forfeiture of assigned boat slip, payment must be made by the date on the invoice. Cash, check, or money order made out the VoF or credit card payment at the Freeport Recreation Center.
7. No refunds will be issued provided there is a pending application for dock space of the same size. Refunds. May not be given after April 30th. There will be a \$50.00 fee for cancelation.
8. If boat owner is considering purchasing a new vessel, they should contact this office prior to purchase to ascertain. If the vessel will fit the parameters of the slip. Berthees who fail to notify this office prior to purchasing a new vessel may find we are unable to accommodate the new vessel. If the vessel is in a different size category, your application will be placed on the existing waiting list as a new applicant.
9. All requests for slip changes/re-assignments must be made in writing through the administration office; Upon availability, changes will Be made in the order of request.
10. Any slip modifications, e.g. satellite dish installation, dockboxes fendering systems etc. require written permission. VoF must be notified prior to any minor repairs to boats.
11. VoF is sometimes required to utilize vacant slips to help facilitate dredging operations, accommodate vessels in distress, or perform other marina functions. Due to these circumstances, patrons may occasionally find another vessel in their slip. This does not constitute a breach of this agreement and in such cases; the VoF may make a temporary slip assignment. It shall be the prerogative of the VoF to use dock lines and any other equipment at any slip, water or electric included, as the need arises.
12. A person shall not operate a boat for hire from a town marina. A special exception may be granted by the VoF for a compelling municipal purpose: scientific, and/or a municipal project.
13. Upon signing this application agreement, I hereby authorize the VoF to remove my vessel or board my vessel.
14. Notwithstanding any reference herein to specific provisions of the Village of Freeport, I agree to conform to all other applicable conditions.
