RE: Parking Restrictions on Albany Avenue

The Department of Public Works has reviewed the parking restrictions on the south end of Albany Avenue. We noticed some discrepancies between the restrictions listed in the Village's Vehicle and Traffic Regulations, and the signage that is currently posted. We would like to modify the parking restrictions to maximize the available parking in the area while providing for adequate sight distances and turning radiuses at the south end of Albany Avenue.

Therefore it is recommended that Counsel's office prepare the necessary documentation to revise the Vehicle and Traffic Regulations as follows:

Sec. 41. Parking prohibited at all times unless otherwise designated.


REMOVE:

Albany Avenue, east and west sides, for a distance of 672 feet north of the south end of Albany Avenue.

ADD:

Albany Avenue, west side, beginning at the northerly curb line of Doxsee Drive and continuing north for 250 feet.

Albany Avenue, east side, beginning at the south curb line of the Albany Avenue boat ramp's south driveway and continuing south to the northerly curb line of Doxsee Drive.
