RE: One-way Traffic at the Northwest Exit of Parking Field #22

The Department of Public Works has reviewed the traffic regulations at the above-referenced area. We have determined that allowing one-way traffic in a westerly direction only will decrease congestion on Buffalo Avenue.


Therefore it is recommended that Counsel's office prepare the necessary documentation to revise the Vehicle and Traffic Regulations as follows:

Sec. 19. One-way traffic: West.

No person shall operate a vehicle or motorcycle except to pass in a westerly direction, in the following designated highways in the Village:
